SOCIETY RULES

1. The entry fee for all classes is 20p, with a maximum of £2
2. All exhibits, except floral art, must be the property of the exhibitor from June before show
3. Exhibitors are limited to one entry per class
4. Exhibits will be accepted on day of show between 9.30am and noon. Each entry to have a society label attached. These available from secretary or at the door on day of show
5. No one to be admitted to show, except judges and stewards during judging. Show opens at 3pm
6. No exhibits to be removed until after presentation of trophies. Photographs will be taken of all Prize winners.
7. Entrants for the garden competitions are permitted to employ labour prior to 15th. May, and have assistance with grass cutting at any time
8. Any exhibitor found in conversation with judges prior to completion of judging will be disqualified
9. The judges' decision is final, no complaints will be entertained
10. Although all reasonable care will be taken, the committee will not be answerable for any damage
11. All Glen residents from Corrimony to Brackla, Lennie to Bunloit, and all children on school roles, are eligible to compete

An Auction Sale will be held at the close of the Show to augment Society Funds, and any Donations of Exhibits will be most gratefully received.

Exhibits remaining after the Prize Giving and Raffle will be deemed to have been donated for the Auction, unless label is marked **NOT FOR AUCTION**
