CYCLING SCOTLAND – BIKEABILITY LEVELS 1 AND 2

We are delighted to be able to offer Bikeability Training to all our P7s next session. It is designed to develop road sense, awareness of traffic dangers, and to improve your child's ability to ride safely. The training will be delivered by three instructors: Ms Wynne and her son Calin, and Mrs McWhirr. Our three instructors have been fully trained to deliver the course. Pupils will work in groups of 6 and will need about 8 sessions.

During the course, your child will receive literature to be completed at home, and your support in going through this with your child will help him or her develop road safety skills, knowledge and attitudes more effectively.

Your child will need a bicycle in a roadworthy condition in order to participate in the course, and it would be helpful if you would check the bicycle, or take it to a cycle shop to be checked, to ensure it is safe to use. The bicycle will be checked at the start of the course (the first week back after the holidays!) **A cycle helmet must be worn at all times when cycling.**

Only the basics of safe cycling can be learnt on this type of course, and it is important that you continue to provide road safety help and guidance to your child after the course.

If you wish your child to participate in the course, please sign and return the slip **to the school**. Please inform Miss Mullin if your child has any particular support needs in this area. Your child will need to bring their bike to school every Wednesday to take part.
