Why do we have to wear seatbelts?

- **If you're in a car crash, you have a high chance of being severely injured without your seatbelt on.**
- **The seatbelt keeps you in your seat.**
- **Everybody should wear a seatbelt or they are at serious risk of an injury.**
- **No matter what size or age you are, you should always wear a seatbelt.**
- **A child under the age of twelve should sit in a booster seat which helps to keep them safe in a crash.**

facts

- **For drivers and front-seat passengers, seat belts reduce the risk of death by 45%, and cut the risk of serious injury by 50%.**
- **More than 15,000 lives have been saved by wearing seatbelts.**
- **Never buckle two children with one seatbelt. Buckling two children into a seat belt is unsafe and illegal.**
