What areas would you like to see us develop?

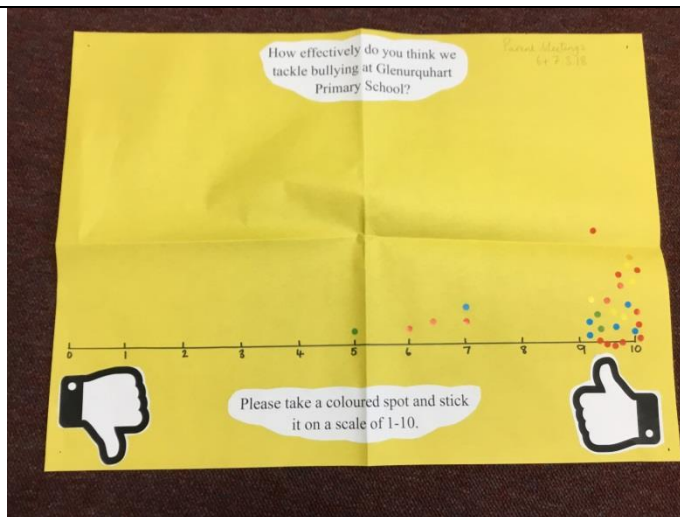
- Carry on with outdoor education provision opportunity development *Outdoor area to be refreshed as the start of May. Outdoor lessons continuing at least weekly.*

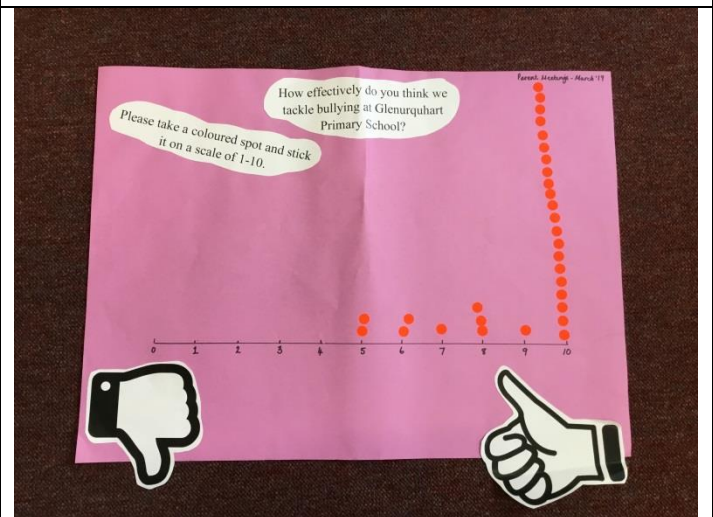
