Want to become involved? You'll play a hugely important role in getting kids into cycling. You don't need to be an expert to become an instructor - anyone with experience and confidence riding a bicycle can train to be one.

We have been offered 3 places at the next training day, which will be held at our school on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March from 9am-5pm. The day will be delivered in a progressive and supportive manner and assessment will be ongoing throughout the day.

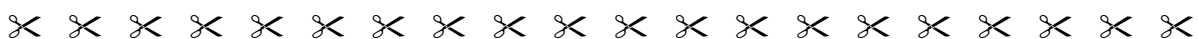
If we can get another 2-3 volunteers trained up, it means we can continue to offer Bikeability Training to our P5s and P6s this year (and beyond!)
