

D: Rights DO NOT have to be earned

Key idea: Rights do not come with any conditions attached and are not linked to responsibilities as they are not earned.

Key word: Unconditional

ALL children aged up to 18 are **Rights holders** within the UNCRC.

Duty Bearers

ALL grown-ups are duty bearers of the UNCRC. They should help children to get their rights.

Today Malala is a rights activist and she was even awarded a Nobel peace prize. She is an incredible duty bearer of the UNCRC.

Governments must do all they can to make sure that every child in their countries can enjoy all the rights in this Convention.



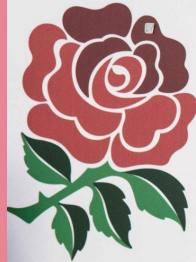
