## English - P1 Transition

Dear Parents and Carers,

As we move towards the Summer break, I'd like to update you on how we are preparing to welcome your child and you to our school. We have had various getting to know you activities already throughout the year including, the class teacher, Mr Macleod visiting the nursery and reading stories to the children. However, these have been constrained prior to Easter, due to the ongoing Covid restrictions. Thankfully, we are now more able to move between services.

As such, we plan to have weekly engagement with the new Primary 1 children. This started yesterday, **Wednesday, 25<sup>th</sup> May** when the current Primary 1/2 class joined the nursery children for Forest Schools. Following this, **each Monday between 9.30 and 10am** (not 13<sup>th</sup> June,) the new Primary 1 children will visit our school to complete various activities both in the classroom and in the school in general so that they feel comfortable and know their new setting and the adults within it.

Furthermore, we would like to invite you and your child to join us for lunch on **Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> June**. We will meet at 11.50am at the school gate and show you into our school hall where lunch will be served as it is now. You can sit with your child and help them to see the routines in place and we can answer any questions you may have. The choices for the day are roast beef, gravy and roast potatoes or sliced chicken sandwich with custard and fruit for dessert. Children's lunches are free and an adult lunch costs £2.65. If you would prefer, a packed lunch can be taken instead. Please complete the attached slip and return it to the school.

Finally, on **Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> June at 6pm**, we will hold a P1 Parent Information Evening where we will introduce our learning and teaching approaches and you will have a chance to see the classroom, around the school and ask questions you may have.

We look forward to getting to your child and you over the coming weeks.
